What a year! This year the Mercer Island Schools Foundation celebrated its 40th Anniversary. Since the Foundation's inception in 1981, more than **\$26 million** has been raised for our schools, thanks to our generous Mercer Island community. The Foundation started as a volunteer-driven, grassroots organization and has grown to become one of the largest and most impactful education foundations in Washington.

The secret of the Foundation's success is the strength of our generous community and the corporate sponsors who partner with us to provide the best education for our students – our future generation of thinkers, creators, and innovators. Thank you for joining us in this critical mission. Never has adaptability and responsiveness been more necessary than over the past two years. The global pandemic turned the world upside down and left our Mercer Island schools to quickly meet the different and emerging needs of over 4,000 students. With your help, the Foundation could extend support immediately. We are proud of this community for coming together to ensure our students receive the rich educational experience they deserve.

We are happy to share this impact report with you and celebrate the many accomplishments of the past year. This year we awarded more than \$50,000 in teacher grants to bring innovative ideas and enrichment to classrooms throughout the District, over \$85,000 for K-12 Math and Science curricula, materials, and new adoptions, and over \$35,000 for Fine Arts, which included visual arts, performing arts, and music. In addition, Foundation dollars provided professional development for teachers, social, emotional, and academic support programs for all grades, and so much more!

Between the Fall All in For Kids campaign and the Spring for Schools campaign, we were able to award the Mercer Island School District **\$808,379**! Every student was truly impacted in so many ways by the programs provided by YOU!

Celebrating 40 Jears OF GIVING







In 1981, Mercer Island parents and community leaders had a dream -

a vision of enriched opportunities for students and teachers through a privately funded organization. It had become clear that public school districts needed more than government funding alone could provide. Thanks to the diligent efforts of Bob Klein and Richard Weinman, the Mercer Island Schools Foundation became a reality. They registered the Mercer Island Schools Foundation as a private, nonprofit 501(c)3 tax-exempt corporation and raised \$3,490 in donations in the first year. Between 1982 and 1990, MISF volunteers increased that to an average of \$100,000 per year. During the 1990s, the Foundation grew substantially, and grants

> increased to over \$225,000 annually.

\$26,000,000 Contributed Since Inception

Penny Yantis joined the MISF board in 1996 and served as president for four years, becoming the first Executive Director in 2002. She

successfully led the

Foundation through many years of growth until her retirement in 2019. The annual MISF Scholarship was renamed the Penny Yantis Scholarship in her honor and is given to a graduating MIHS senior each year. Initially, the Foundation did most of its fundraising through mailers and a Phone-A-Thon held over two evenings each fall. From the outset, the Phone-A-Thon was very successful, and donations grew annually.

However, by 2003, contributions from the Phone-A-Thon had plateaued. At this time, the MISF board added another fundraising event, and the first Breakfast of Champions was held in the spring of 2004. The Breakfast took place in the MIHS gym and raised over \$150,000. Since then, the Breakfast of Champions has become a regular spring event, with an attendance of over 600 people each year and regularly bringing in over \$300,000 in donations on the event day.

Community support for the Mercer Island Schools Foundation has continued to grow. Since the Foundation's inception, parents, community members, and businesses in Mercer Island have invested more than \$26M, creating an ongoing legacy of excellence in education. This tremendous success lies in the fact that the Foundation was born in a community that places a high value on education. Annual support for Mercer Island public schools through the Foundation allows the District to provide the most up-to-date, world-class curricula, the best professional development for educators, enrichment opportunities for students, teacher grants, and programs to provide social, emotional, and academic support. Thank you to this generous community that helps to guarantee an exceptional teaching and learning experience for every student.


Financial overview of a bounce-back year.

"I received grant to provide for Poetrypalooza, a program to celebrate National Poetry Month and to get kids to read an array of poetry by contemporary poets. The students at IMS and MIHS create brackets, kind of like March Madness, and then to read and vote on their favorite poems over the month and see whose bracket best predicts the choices of MIHS and IMS students. So far, we have over 150 students involved. The winner was Ha Jin, a poet who stayed in the U.S. after Tiananmen Square and writes poems that are introspective about his relationship with both his adopted country and his country of origin."

Listening to poetry helps students to become fluent readers and creative writers, while writing poetry helps them learn to revise their ideas and develop a precision with language. Learning a repertoire of poems gives children and adults shared memories, a shared heritage, and shared understandings.

Poetry can enrich instruction in reading, writing, speaking and listening, capture students with its musicality, and spark their creative and critical thinking.
